

Mayor David Allaire

A lifelong resident of Rutland, Mayor David Allaire attended Christ the King School, Mount Saint Joseph Academy, and Castleton State College. For the last 30 years, he has been employed in outside sales, becoming Sales Manager at Interstate Batteries last year.

He served on the Rutland City Board of Aldermen for 19 years, including nine years as Board President, and served as Chair of the Charter and Ordinance, Recreation, and Public Safety Committees. He was elected Mayor of Rutland in March 2017.

He also served in the Vermont Legislature for six years as a State Representative, during which time he served on the House Transportation Committee (for four years) and the House Ways and Means Committee (for two years). He is the Vice Chair of the Rutland Region Planning Commission and a board member of Recovery House, Vermont Rail Council, Vermont Rail Action Network, and Operation Lifesaver.
